NEWPORT

INTERMENT OF MR. WILLIAM NUNN. – The death of Mr. William Nunn, of Shide, took place rather suddenly on Wednesday, the 13th instant, at his residence, Lynwood-villa. The deceased was 81 years of age, and was a cousin of the late Mr. Henry Nunn, the latter having established a factory at Broadlands, Newport, for the manufacture of the once greatly noted Isle of Wight lace, and the deceased was, we are informed, interested in the business, which gave employment to a large number of the inhabitants of Newport and district. On Monday the funeral took place, the bearers being selected from the surviving workmen once connected with the factory. The Rev. W. Leggatt Sharpe conducted the burial service, the interment taking place at St. Paul's Church-yard.
