NONAGENARIAN'S DEATH. – The death took place on the 7th inst. of an esteemed resident of Staplers, in the person of Mr. Charles Moody, wood dealer, ? , who had reached the advanced age of 91. Deceased was probably the oldest member of the congregation of St. Paul's Church, having attended ever since the church was built. He often spoke of having as a boy run round the foundations when it was being built. He was a staunch Conservative. So well was he that he continued working at his business until 89 years of age. The funeral took place on Monday at St. Paul's, the Rev. Miles Atkinson (vicar) officiating. The interment was in the old churchyard. The mourners were Mrs. Cooke (daughter), Messrs. James, Herbert, George and Samuel Moody (sons), Messrs. Charles Harry, Fred, and Ted Moody (grandsons), and Mrs. James Moody (daughter-in-law).
